




N.K. BAGRODIA GROUP OF SCHOOLS

THE GUIDELINES PROVIDED BY THE DOE WERE STRICTLY FOLLOWED.





BESIDES UNDERSTANDING THE LAW, IT HELPED THE STUDENTS TO LEARN THE PROCEEDINGS OF THE COURT.




















WORLD CONSERVATION DAY/ HEPATITIS DAY



The workshop was divided into two sessions, the first in the morning and the second in the afternoon. In the morning session a lecture demonstration was conducted by Mr Pankaj Munjal. Mr. Pankaj Munjal talked about issues related to gender inequality in our society. A Powerpoint presentation on the topic Gender Sensitivity was shown along with a few videos. The manner in which complaints are to be addressed was also explained. He provided a number of suggestions to promote gender sensitivity in the school environment in order to educate and inculcate

gender se n8sitivity right from childhood. The participants participated actively in the open housediscussion and were appreciative about getting an opportunity to know and discuss gender sensitivity at school. Around 50 participants from various schools attended this workshop. They were given a certificate of participation. It is hoped that schools also conduct such workshops in future.

The workshop was attended by about 50 teachers of various subjects. It was divided into two sessions, the first in the morning and the second in the afternoon. In the morning session, Dr Kumar started the workshop with a very interesting and exciting activity, the paper aeroplanes and told to write one word which make you feel happy. With this activity teacher can know emotional intelligence of a child, also by engaging all students they learn to be more interactive with each other. She beautifully explained the journey of self awareness to self acceptance. Then the workshop moved with one activity of logo making on happiness. She put emphasis on why we do not feel happy and how not to carry baggage of unhappiness...try to recycle by forgetting or forgiving. In the post lunch session, she narrated a cobbler story and told to distinguish between personal and professional front and balance them. The most important part of the work was to make students learn impulse control by breaking conventional thinking. A teacher should say I teach Science instead of I teach children. Never punish the child but get confession note from him/her.keep your narrative positive. In workshop all teachers played with Simon says.....It was really effective in impulse control. The last but not the least Creating a treasure trunk of gratitude Like. I am grateful for.... How can I nurture a garden of optimism. It is hoped that schools also conduct such workshops in future. educators when making instruction and assessment decisions.


