




EARTHDAY


PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- 1. Walking is one of the cheapest way of getting around, being active and its beneficial for our planet, too. Lets be environment friendly let's walk! "Pattern walking was arranged for kids to help them to learn to make judgement, to understand what comes next, to make logical connections and to use reasoning skills."
