



The eminent guests' list included Smt. Anita Karwal, Secretary, Department of School Education and Literacy, Smt. Nidhi Chhibber, Chairperson, Central Board of Secondary Education and Ms. Nidhi Pandey, Commissioner, Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan.

Ms. Binny Gupta, Incharge of Primary Department attended the program.

Speaking on the occasion, Mr. Pradhan said that the National Education Policy- NEP 2020 is deeply inspired by the philosophy of Swami Vivekananda. He added that value-based education is important for building a future-ready and socially conscious generation.

He emphasised on the need to create 21st century citizens capable of taking global responsibilities and NEP 2020 with focus on a teacher-led holistic education system for students.

For the smooth conduction of teaching learning process, an orientation program was conducted for the parents of primary department in two slots. The highlights of the event are as follows:


- Parents were informed about the extra classes to be conducted on Thursdays, fourth Saturdays, zero period and activity periods.

 - The importance of persistent hard work was emphasised upon.












Mathematics Workshop 28.09.22 Wednesday










Such activities at an early stage not only helps to instil values among children but also add to the holistic development of child.
























परिश्रम का महत्त्व






MASK MAKING




"Good handwriting is a very important academic skill part of our heritage. The loss of this skill is like the loss of a language."

Maths - *Activity on Measurement*


"*One accurate

Measurement is important in providing links between strands of mathematics. For example, it provides a rich and meaningful context for the use of number skills and of spatial concepts. Measurement also helps to coordinate between mathematics with school subjects.

To understand the concept of Measurement better and to visualise various tools of measuring Length, Weight and Capacity, the students were helped to perform an activity in their scrap files in which they pasted pictures of various measuring tools like weighing scale, digital scale, ruler, measuring tape, etc. Students used stickers and cutouts and performed the activity with utmost creativity.


E.V.S. ACTIVITY Festivals Galore

India is a land of festivals. Festivals are the carriers of peace and joy. People of different religions live in harmony and celebrate their festivals with great pomp and show.



The activity focused to educate the students that many religions have coexisted peacefully in India for centuries and need to do so in the future.








'A man's character may be learned from the adjectives which he habitually uses in conversation."



make a big difference to the world. Children made beautiful paper bags and also took a pledge to 'Say no to plastic bags'.

























CLASS-V MATHEMATICS Fun-Based E-Learning

The villagers get to actively participate in the decision making process at the grassroot level through the Panchayat and this practice brings true democracy to their doorsteps.





















The students of primary department are regularly engaged in physical activities which provides them with the ability and confidence to be physically active for the lifetime.








CREATIVITY AT ITS BEST


Each activity was designed to keep the children engrossed and also helped the students to retain the concepts of mathematical operations well.


























Class - II Maths Game


The students participated enthusiastically and enjoyed the game. The game also generated interest among students for the subject and helped develop their psychomotor skill!

The outcome of the activity was excellent as students presented the data in a beautiful and innovative manner. They accomplished the task with enthusiasm and zeal.
































Class 1

Grandparents' Day Celebration Class - V Date - 9th September 2022



It is a true blessing to have our grandparents with us and we can cherish their fond memories for ever and ever!


















































Teachers Day Card Making Activity


