














Parent-Teacher Meeting Classes III - V 15th October'22

World Food Day Class - V Date - 16-10-22




Food brings people together in a variety of ways.

A PPT and video on Diwali were showcased to the students to give them more information about how and why we celebrate Diwali.










































Bagless Day Fun Class V Diwali Celebration 21.10.22




Maths Activity on Time Class II Date - 21.10.22

















Grade 3 Mathematics Tangram


To enhance the students'knowledge about the same, an activity was conducted for the students of Class III wherein they were given information about the important inventions in the field of travel and communication and their inventors.





'A person with a scant vocabulary will almost certainly be a weak thinker.'


In order to enhance students' vocabulary, various activities were conducted in the class.

*Word of the Day was one such activity which created a cascade of thinking and lead to better command over language.







*They drew and coloured the object and tabulated their findings.


*The students observed the difference between the crystals of sugar and salt with the help of magnifying glass (hand lens) and noted the variation.

*The students conducted the test for solubility of some common substances and recorded their findings.


