
ENGLISH RHYME RECITATION ACTIVITY - INTER





























CORNER DISPLAY - FESTIVALS


COGNITIVE SKILLS - PROBLEM SOLVING

Children learn to recognize patterns that make their world more understandable and predictable. The activities related to problem solving and sequential thinking were done.











COGNITIVE SKILLS - SEQUENCING
