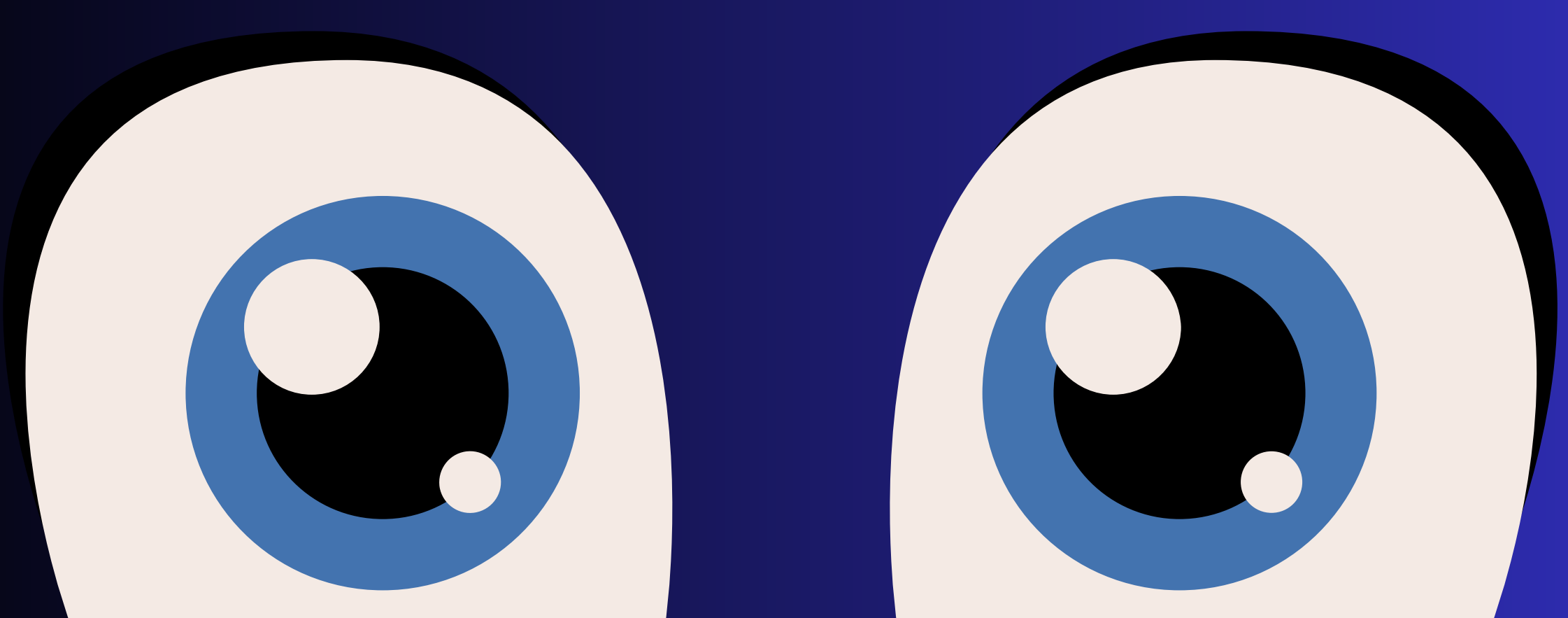
Colours Spree

Parts of the Body.

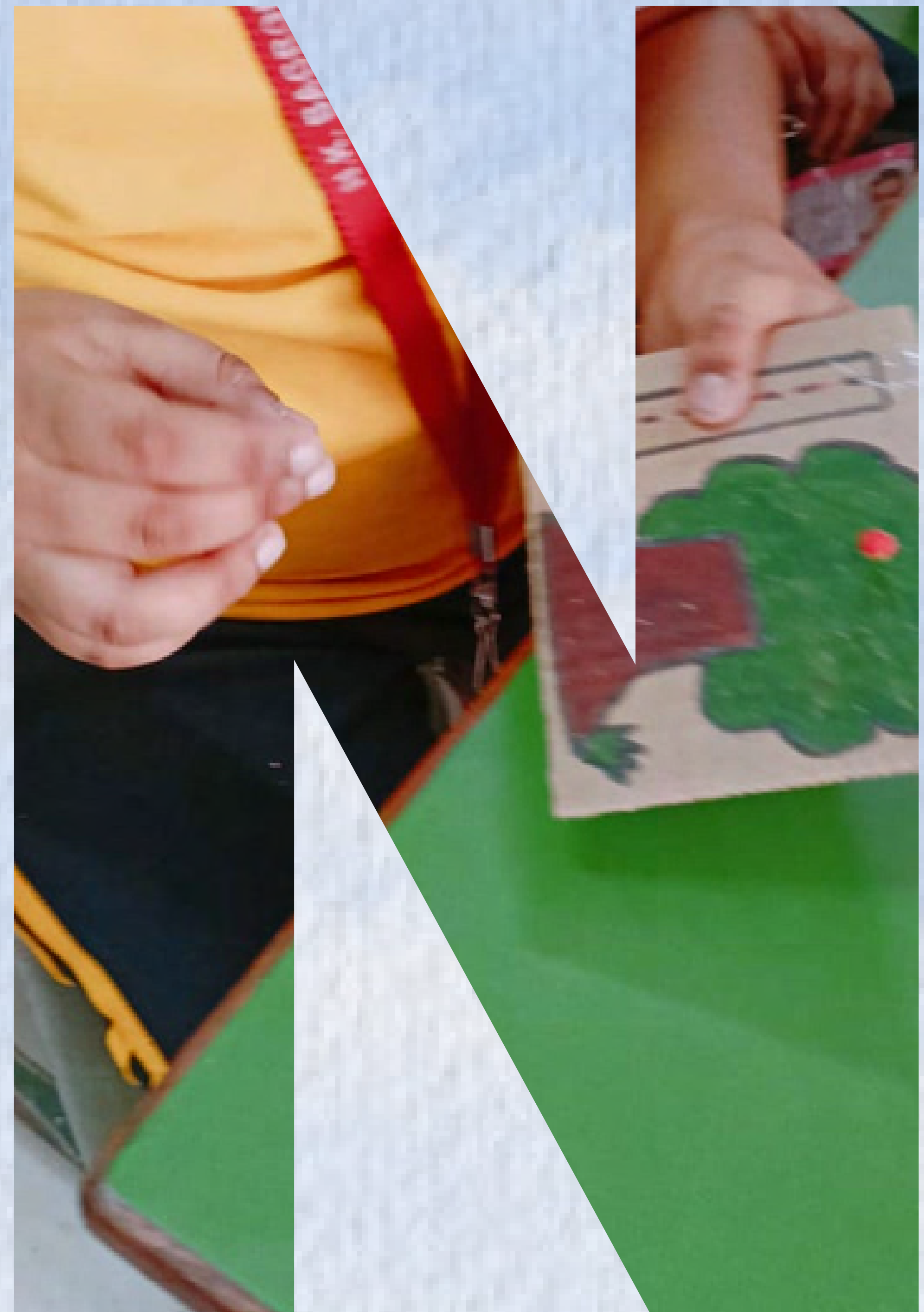

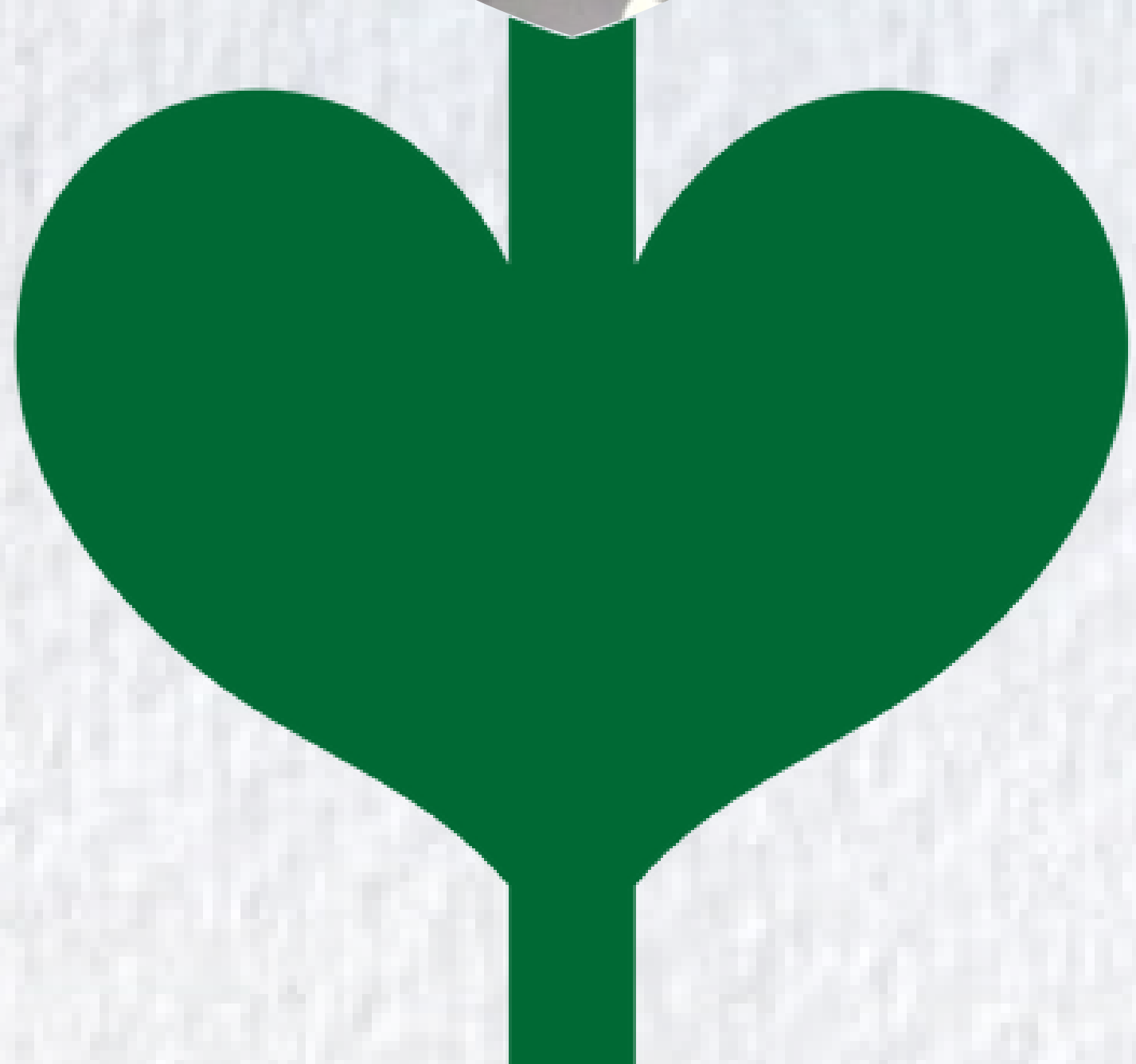

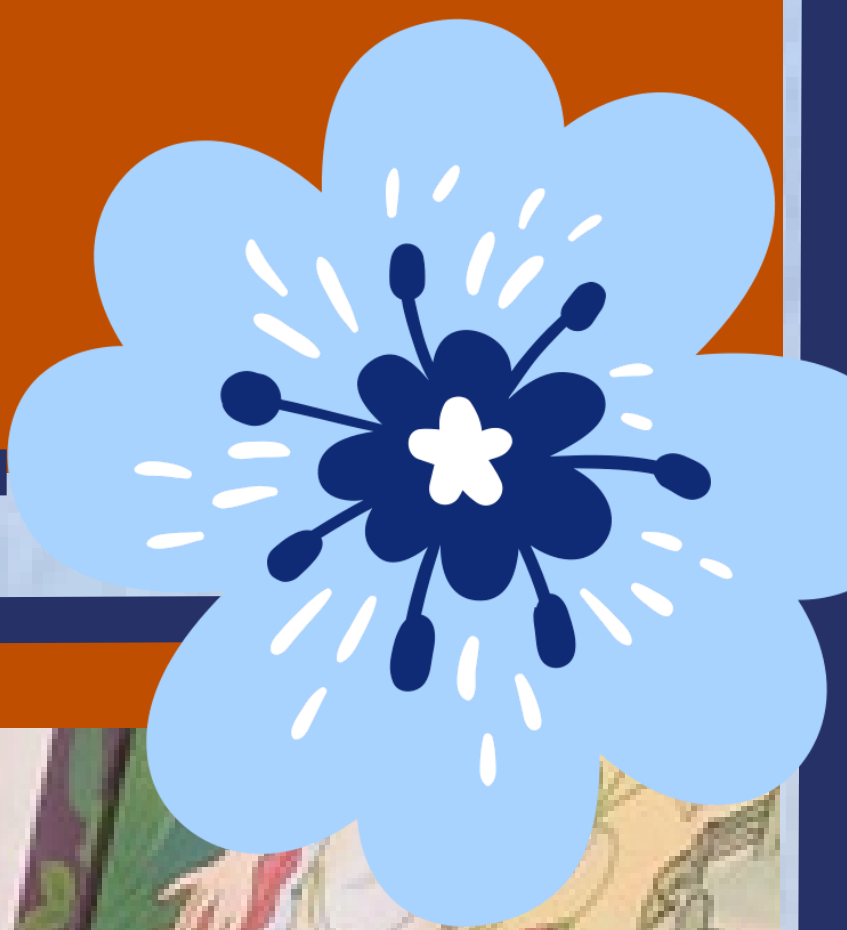
Show and Tell Activity

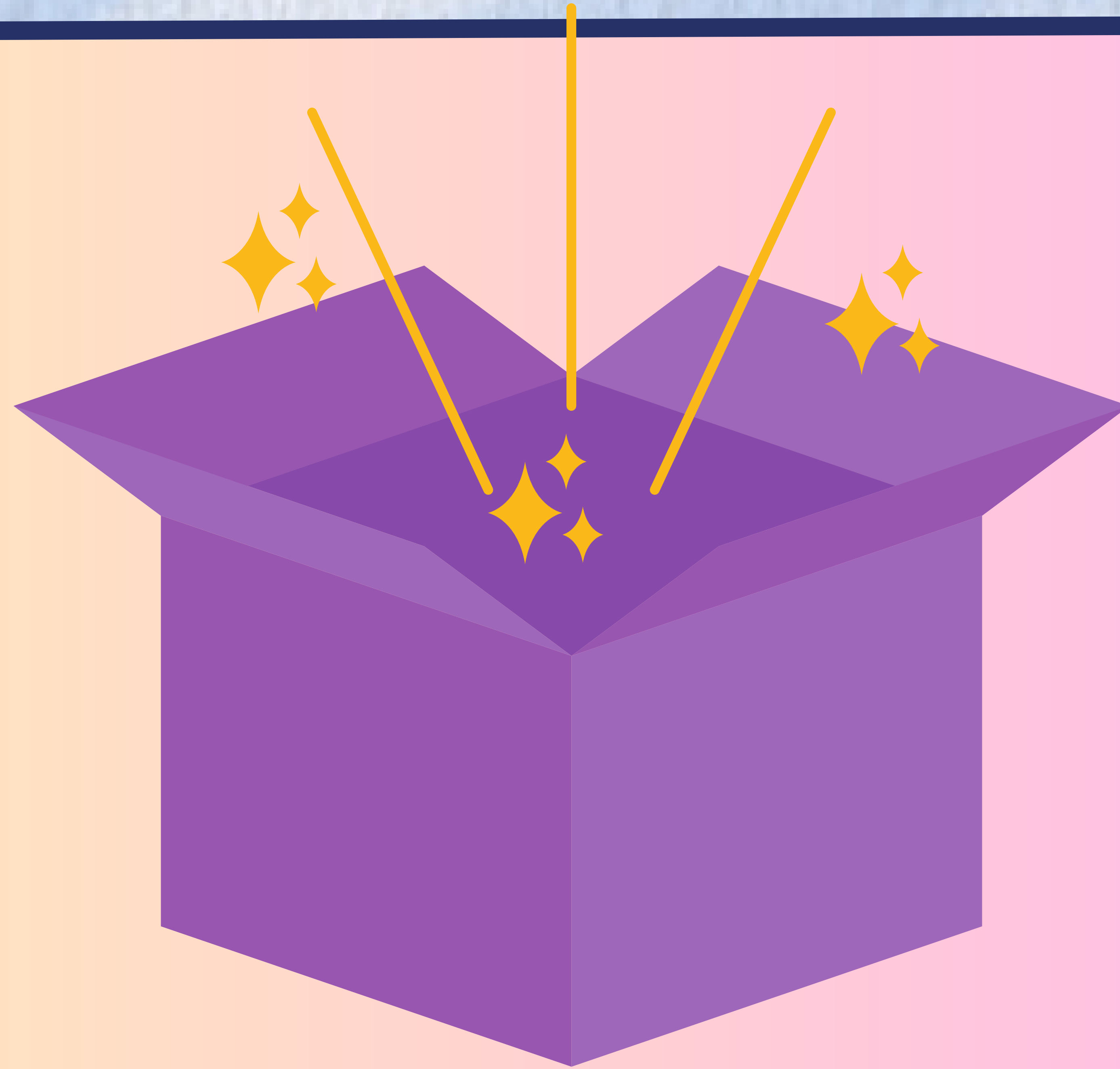

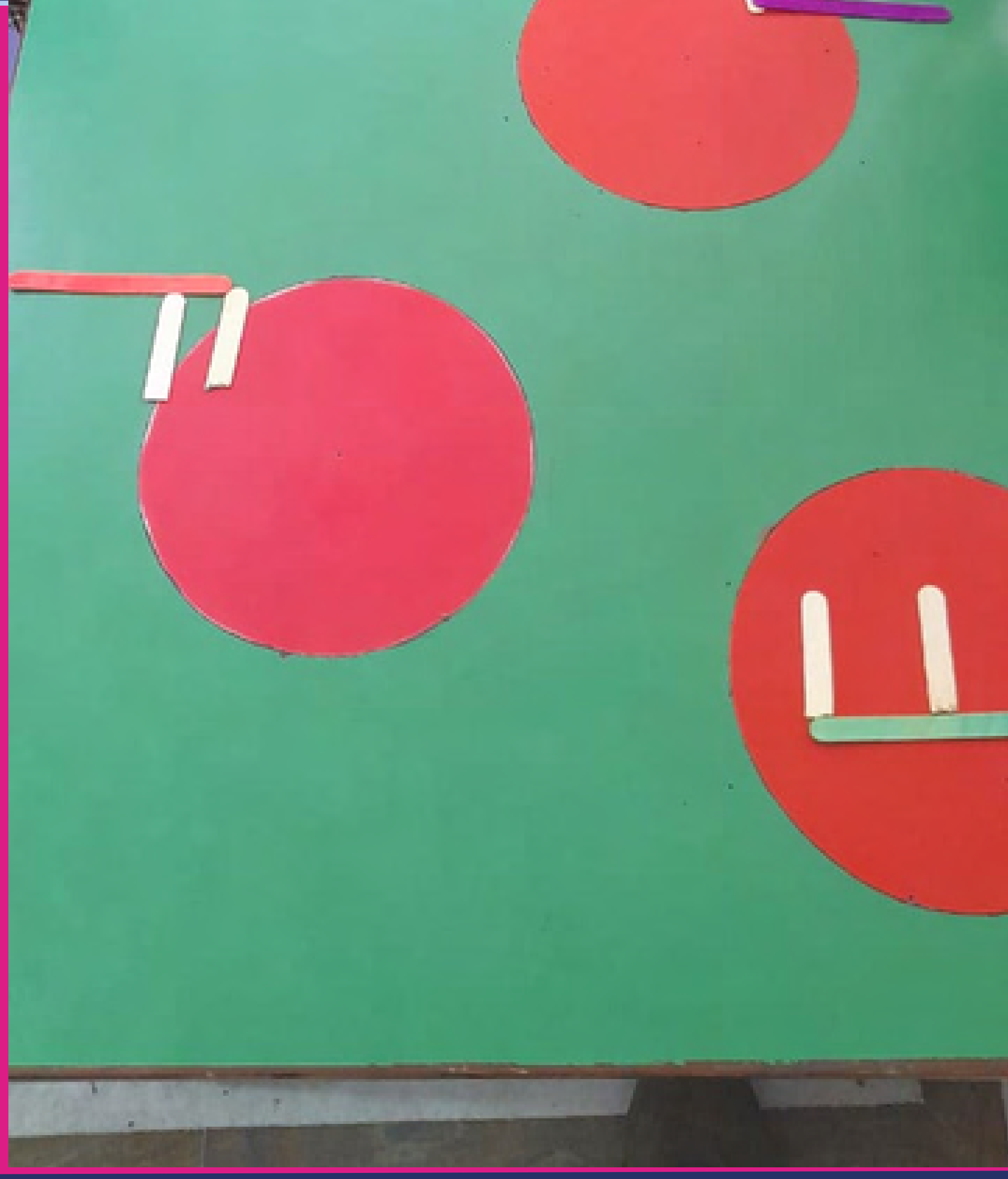

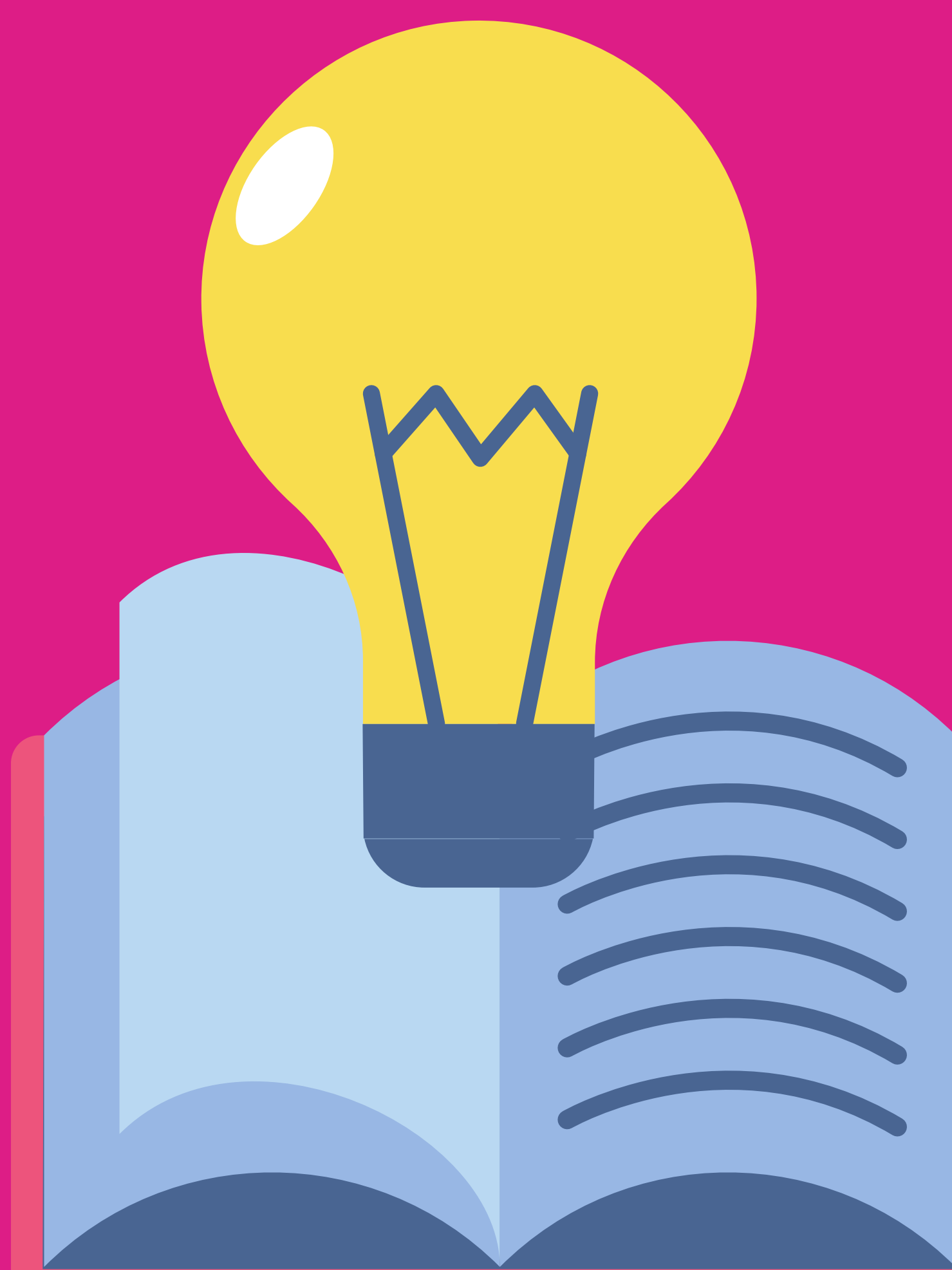
