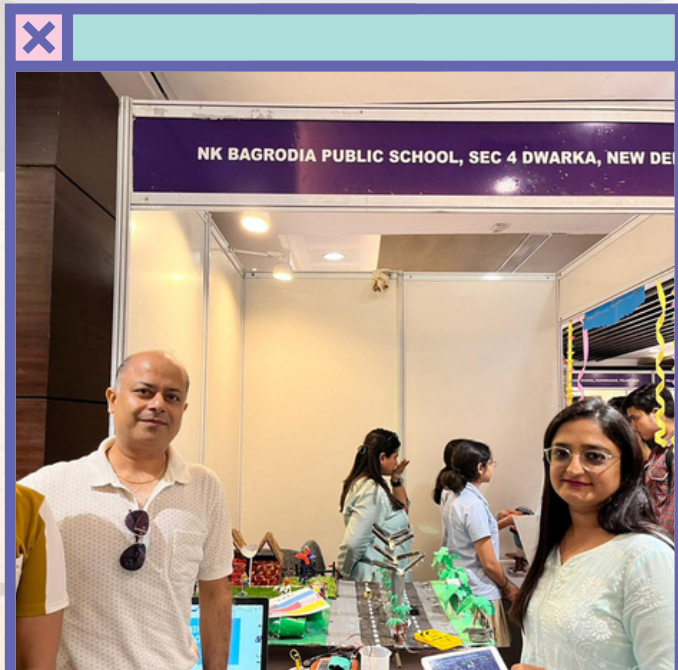
Topic: Learning Outcomes and Pedagogies

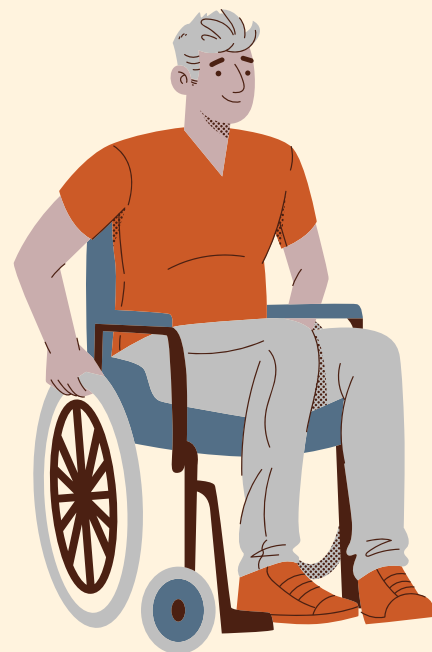
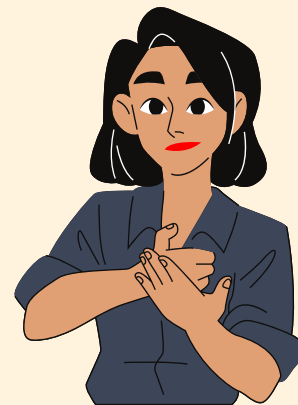
WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY



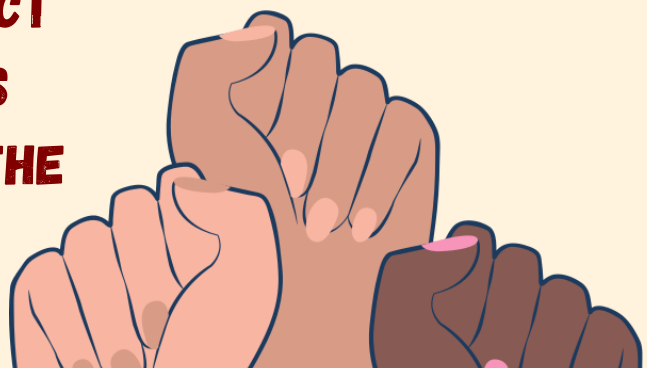

THE HONOURABLE MINISTER FOR THE ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND WILDLIFE MR. GOPAL RAI WAS THE SPECIAL GUEST. THE EVENT WAS GRACED BY THE HONOURABLE CHIEF MINISTER OF DELHI, MR. 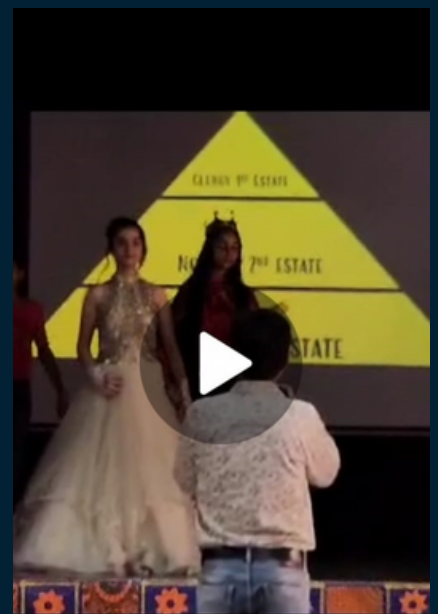


FRENCH DAY

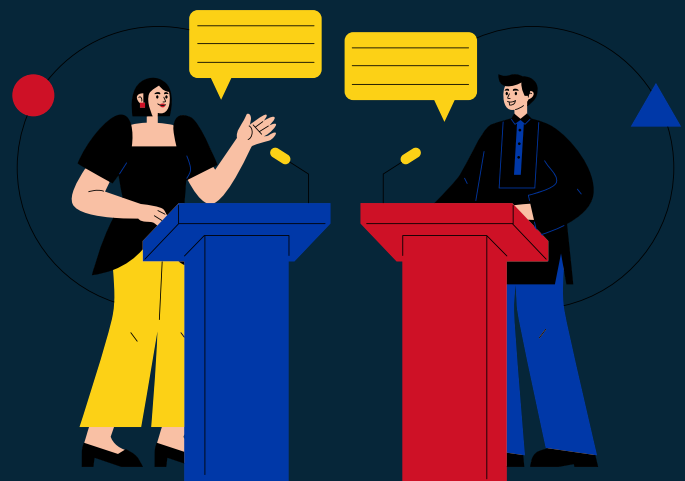


Inter - House English Debate







INTER SCHOOL HINDI DEBATE COMPETITION

MOCK FIRE DRILL

AT NKBPS, ROHINI

MILLETS TO MOUTH



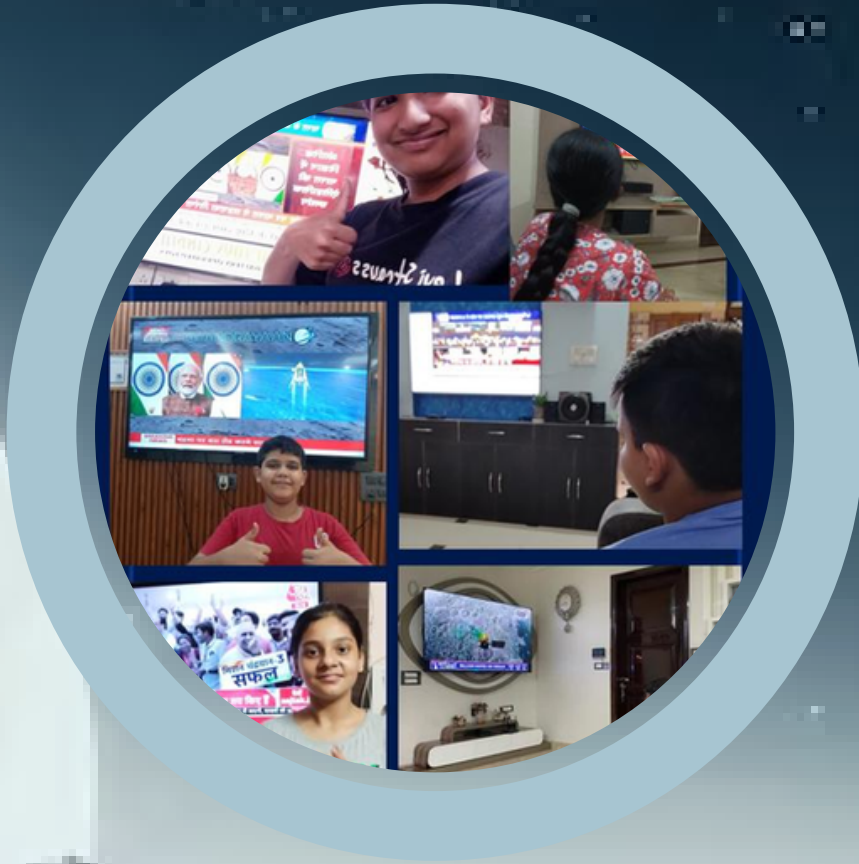

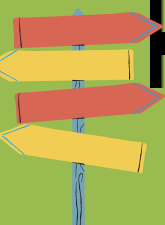
VISIT TO AMRIT UDYAN

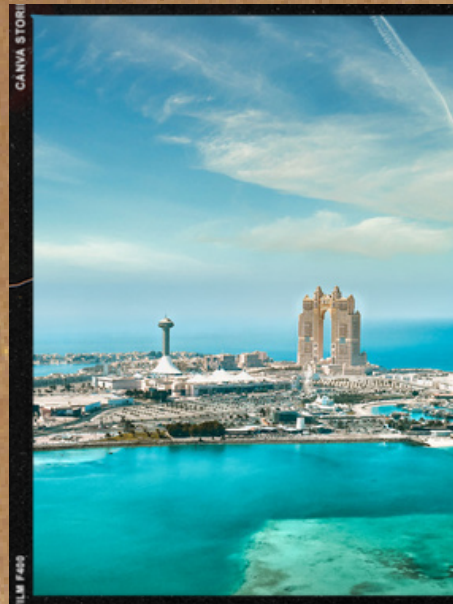
TRIP TO DUBAI

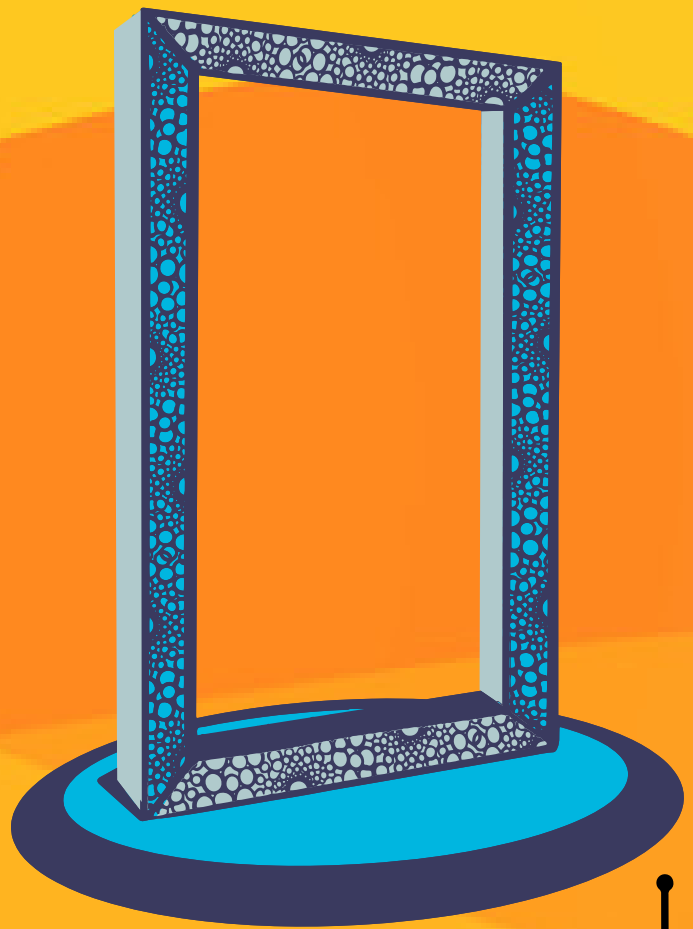

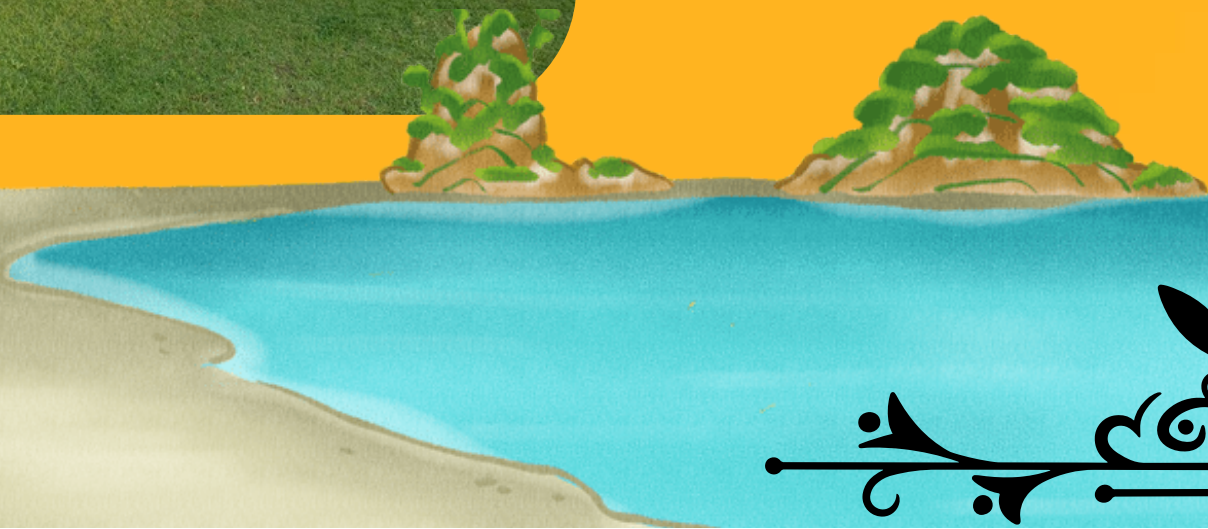


6. Dubai Frame:
