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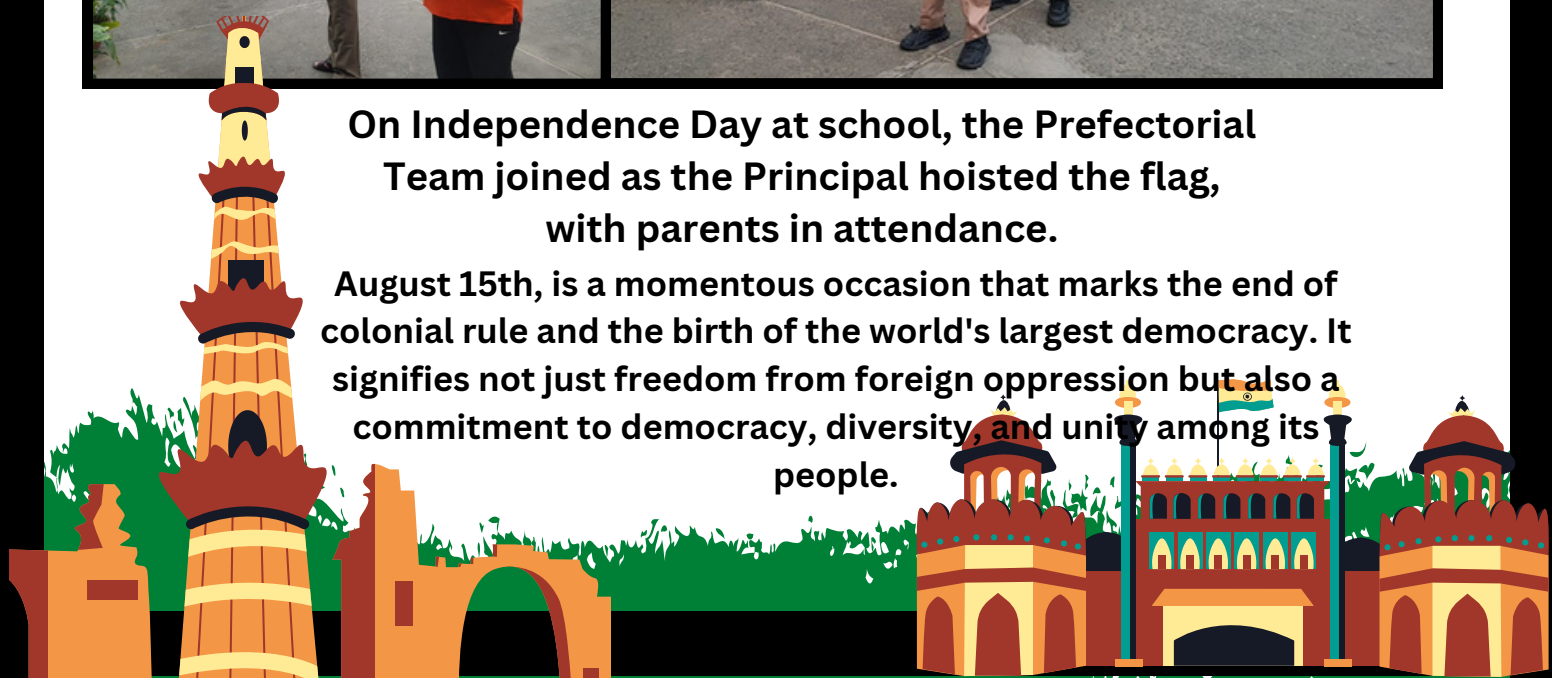
INDEPENDENCE DAY

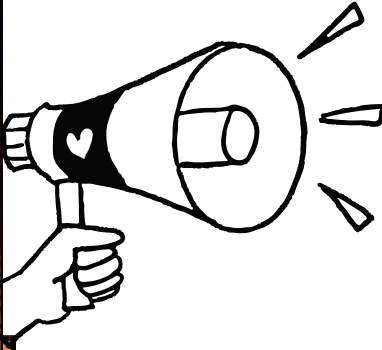

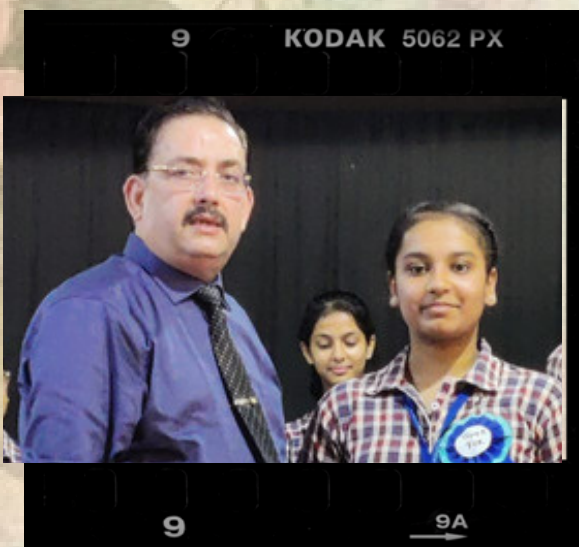

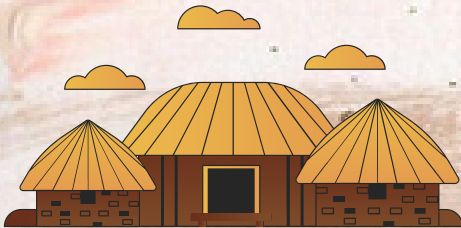

REPORT OF ADITYA L1 MISSION WORKSHOP

The school participated in the workshop "India's Own Aditya L1 mission", where 15 students from classes X to XII went to Nehru Planetarium on 4 September 2023 from 9:30 am to 12:00pm. The Workshop was headed by Dr. Dipankar Banerjee, Director, Aryabhata Research Institute of observational Sciences.

The workshop was a highly interactive session aimed at understanding Aditya L1, India's first solar mission to Sun. Dr. Dipankar Banerjee, enlightened the students about various solar features that helped them understand the physics of the sun. The students also gained insights into Aditya L1 mission's working by understanding the trajectory of the satellite to reach lagrange point I from where it will perform a halo-orbital motion, all the while observing the dynamics of our own star. Following the programme was a doubt discussion session where students interacted with Dr. Banerjee. Next was a quiz, hosted for both School and college students by Dr. Vaibhav Pant and Dr. S. Krishna Prasad. The students participated in the quiz with exuberant zeal and enthusiasm.

The programme culminated with a solar exhibition where students observed various scientific wonders and theories through hands-on experiments and 3D models. The Solar observatory was the central attraction of the exhibition. The program was a great success and motivated the students to know more about the boundless universe where exists a small planet we call "home".

INDIA'S OWN ADITYA L1 MISSION

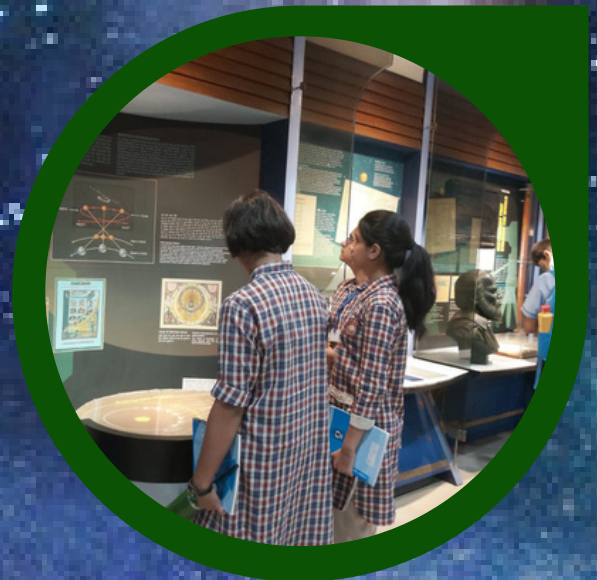

"THE NAVAL MOTIVATIONAL TEAM AT NKBPS, ROHINI"



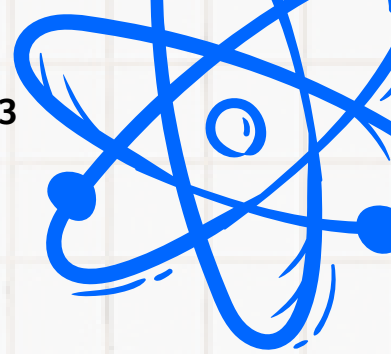

AIIMS EXHIBITION

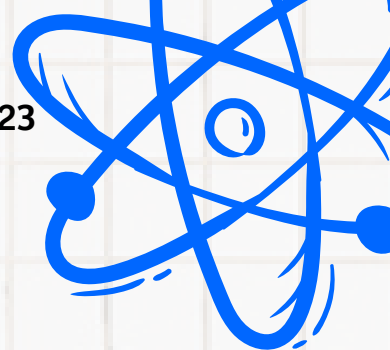

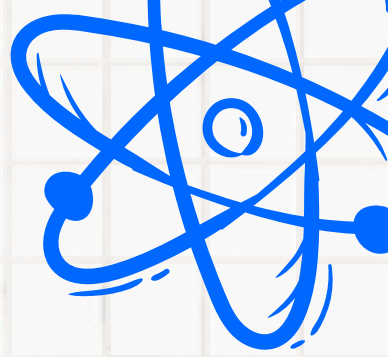

A visit to the lecture hall was the perfect end to a perfect day.

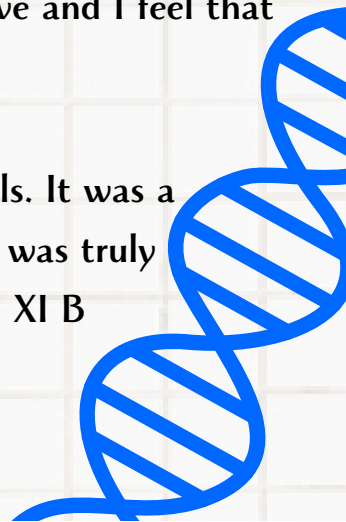

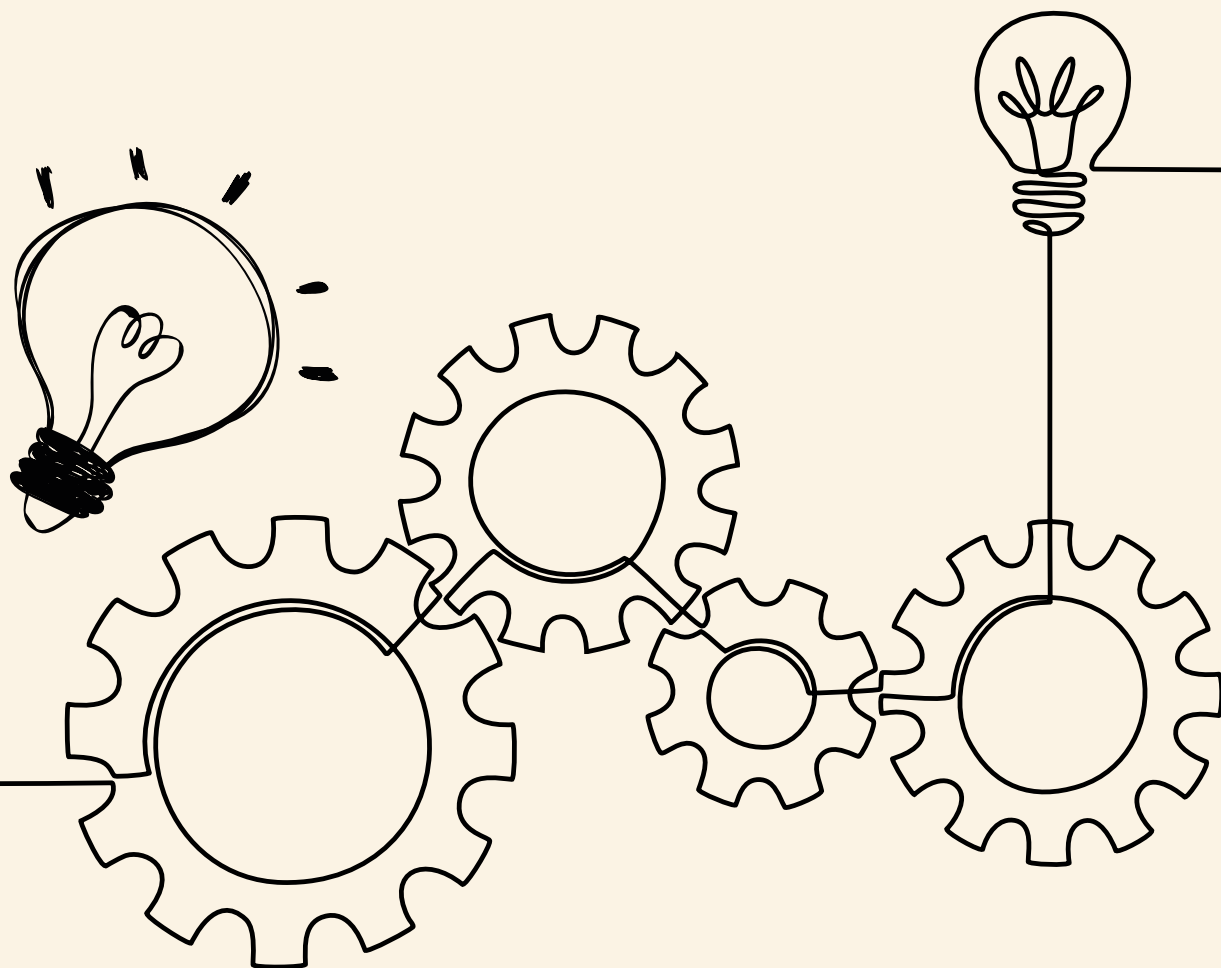




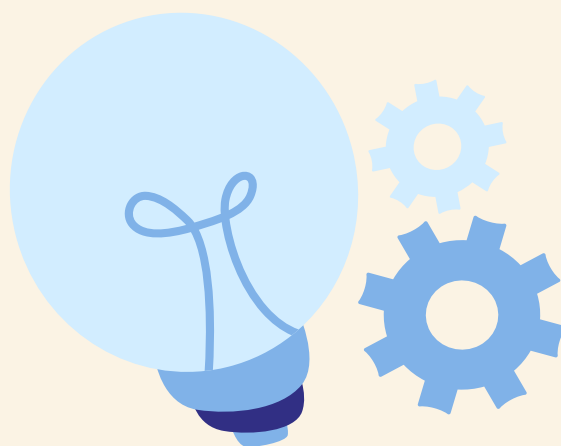
